Item No. 3: Allocation of funds for Prof. G.S. Gosal Memorial Lecture on April 1, 2023

While honorarium for speaker and person chairing the session shall remain unchanged, members evolved a consensus to organize memorial lecture on 'need based at the lowest possible cost'.

Two additional discussions were as follows:

- to hold Executive Council and GBM in the Seminar Hall of the Department of Geography; and
- (iv) to organize a National Seminar in conjunction with Professor G.S. Gosal Memorial Lecture.

Item No. 4: Grants from ICSSR

The Secretary informed that the ICSSR had sanctioned grant of Rs. 80,000/- for the publication of journal for the year 2021-22 out of which Rs. 72,000/- have been received.

It was also suggested to enroll more life members and organize national seminars on regular basis. These efforts are essential to sustain the publication of journal.

Item No. 5: Revision of Institutional subscription rates

The request for increase in discount to institutional subscription was discussed. After deliberations, discount of 20% was agreed upon unanimously by the members for institutional agencies in order to extend the publicity as well as earning from journal.

Item No. 6: Publication status of journal Volume-44 of June, 2022

Prof. Surya Kant informed the house that volume-44, No. 1 is under process. The regular publication of the journal on time was appreciated.

Item No. 7: Professional printing of journal

In order to streamline the publishing of journal, the services of Delhi based M/s Print India Publications is under consideration. They have agreed to print, publish and distribute Population Geography journal on the following conditions:

- Annually charge Rs. 80,000/- from us for five years for printing the journal (200 numbers of each volume);
- For the first five years, they shall provide us with 100 complimentary copies and for further purchase, they shall give us a 50% discount;
- 3. Online free access to all life members; and
- 4. After five years, they will not charge anything but provide only 25-30 complimentary copies.

Item No. 10: Secretarial Assistance-Honorarium to Shakti Yadav

After deliberations, it was decided not to fix any honorarium for any person to do task performed on ad hoc basis. Any suitable amount based on the task be paid to any person subject to a maximum of Rs. 2000/- per year.

Before the meeting ended, Prof. Gopal Krishan shared the following:

- (1) He expressed to honour 12 persons for their contribution in promoting the activities of APGI and the expenditure for mementoes will be borne by him;
