**Manuscripts** The maximum length of a paper should be about 6000 words. The manuscripts must be submitted in soft/hard copy typed in MS-Word, Times New Roman, font 12, in 1.5 spacing. Original Maps, if any, are to be included in the text as well as separately in .jpg format. Manuscripts should be carefully checked before submission and must be preceded by a covering page stating the title of the paper, full name(s) of the author(s) along with mailing address. An abstract of about 100-150 words outlining scope, methodology, and main findings of the work should be given in the beginning. Paper must not have been published previously in any periodical or book and should not be submitted elsewhere until a decision is received from this Journal.

**References** should be arranged in alphabetical and chronological order. Follow APA style guide latest edition for referencing. Some examples:
